Coach Kendrick and our event organizers will be issuing formal invitations to attend this three day hoops extravaganza, not only to the competing 48 players in the male and female divisions, but also to all CIS and CCAA coaches in the Atlantic provinces to come and witness this event. We are thrilled to announce this year's event will be held on the beautiful campus of Holland College, in the heart of Charlottetown!

All players will be placed in a drill station group (four groups of 12) and on a team (six teams of eight). Players will be put through a series of stations showcasing their individual and team skills on the opening evening, followed by two intense days (five full court games per team) of competitive games. Coach Kendrick's staff will include six excellent instructors with high school, college/university, or pro experience, as well as referees for every game.

The player's fee for this event is \$175.48, and includes the opportunity to compete in this event with its superb staff, the chance to be seen by many college and university coaches who may be in attendance, a full program, and a Great 48 Shoot-Out reversible jersey.

The female event will be held from Friday, August 17 at 6pm until Sunday, August 19 at 5pm. The male event will be held on Friday August 24 at 6pm until Sunday, August 26 at 5pm. Both events will be taking place at the Centre for Community Engagement on the Holland College campus.

Invited players must return their completed registration form and fees paid in full prior to June 1, 2018. Failure to do so will result in your invitation being withdrawn and the opportunity being given to another worthy candidate.

This event is the brainchild of current Island Storm Head Coach Tim Kendrick, and is set to showcase 48 of Atlantic Canada's top high school aged male and female basketball players.

Coach Kendrick's career has spanned 30 years and he has coached at every level.

Coach Kendrick spent 22 years as the head coach of Horton High School's Division I boys program, where he amassed an overall record of 707 wins against 189 losses. This included 16 Regional Championships and back-to-back N.S.S.A.F. Provincial Championships. His time at Horton also included a nationally recognized 73 game win streak.

Spending six seasons as head coach of the UPEI Panthers, Kendrick finished with an overall record of 113-88. Over his six years at UPEI, his Panthers had the second best record in the A.U.S., with five straight winning records and three 20-win seasons. Coach Kendrick is only the second coach in UPEI history to record over 100 wins, including an AUS Coach of the Year award in 2012.

Coach Kendrick has also represented his home province of Nova Scotia several times in Canada Basketball events as Head Coach, culminating in winning a silver medal with the N.S. U17 Boys at the 2009 Canada Games.

During his first year as coach of the Island, Coach Kendrick led the Storm to its best record since the 2014-15 NBL season.

In his long career, Coach Kendrick has coached over 200 players who went on to play basketball with college, university and even professional teams.
